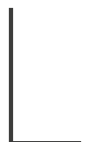


HUANG Tu-Shui

1895-1930, born in Taipei, Taiwan

■ CHRONOLOGY

- 1911** Graduated from Tataocheng Public School (now Taiping Elementary School) and enrolled at Taipei Mandarin School (now National Taipei University of Education), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1915** Taught at Taiping Public School (now Taiping Elementary School), Taipei, Taiwan
Received aid for studying abroad from the Taiwan Branch of Japan Association, entered Tokyo School of Fine Arts (now Tokyo University of the Arts) to study wood carving, followed Buddhist carving master Takamura's teaching, Tokyo, Japan
- 1919** Transferred to the fifth grade of Tokyo School of Fine Arts, completed *Sweet Dew*, Tokyo, Japan
- 1920** *Fan Tong* (or *Chui Di Shan Tong*), "The 2nd Imperial Art Exhibition of Japan", Selected; the first Taiwanese artist to be selected into the "Imperial Art Exhibition of Japan", Japan
Studied oil painting from lecture notes sent by mail from Japan, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1921** *Sweet Dew*, "The 3rd Imperial Art Exhibition of Japan", Selected, Japan
- 1922** *Posing Woman*, "The 4th Imperial Art Exhibition of Japan", Selected, Japan
- 1924** *Outskirts (Jiao Wai)*, "The 5th Imperial Art Exhibition of Japan", Selected, Japan
- 1925** Eliminated from "The 6th Imperial Art Exhibition of Japan", Japan
- 1926** Completed *Sakya*, placed at Mengjia Longshan Temple, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1928** Completed *Guitu* upon Taiwan Governor request, Taiwan
- 1930** Reorganized the "Imperial Art Exhibition of Japan", decided to create large-scale relief *Water Buffaloes* (formerly *Southland*) to participate in the exhibition, yet he was late to send the work; 36 years old passed away on December 21st
- 1931** "Huang Tu-Shui Posthumous Exhibition", Old Department of Taiwan Presidential Building (now Zhongshan Hall), Taipei, Taiwan



- 1936** Posthumous work *Water Buffaloes* donated to Taipei Public Hall (now Zhongshan Hall), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1938** “Huang Tu-Shui and Chen Chih-Chi Memorial Exhibition”, Taipei Education Center (now National 228 Memorial Museum), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1983** With help of the Ministry of Culture sculpture *Water Buffaloes* was completed and exhibited at Taipei Fine Arts Museum, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1989** “Huang Tu-Shui Sculpture Exhibition”, National Museum of History, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1995** “Huang Tu-Shui’s 100th Birthday Anniversary Exhibition”, Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts, Kaohsiung, Taiwan
- 2015** “Tribute to the Masters – Exhibition of Taiwan’s Eleven Senior Sculptors”, Zhongshan Hall, Taipei, Taiwan
