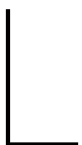


# YEN Shui-Long

1903-1997, born in Tainan, Taiwan

- 1918** Graduated from the Tainan Government Teacher Training Department, Tainan, Taiwan
- 1922** Enrolled at the Tokyo School of Fine Arts (now Tokyo University of the Arts), Tokyo, Japan
- 1927** Graduated from the Western Painting Department, Tokyo University of the Arts, Tokyo, Japan
- Together with Chen Cheng-Po, Yang San-Lang, Li Mei-Shu, Liao Chi-Chun and others formed the “Red Island Painting Society”, Taipei, Taiwan
- “Artists of the Chiyang Painting Club – Group Exhibition”, Tainan Public Hall, Tainan, Taiwan
- Nude*, “The First Taiwan Fine Arts Exhibition”, Selected, Taiwan
- 1929** Received Master’s degree from Tokyo University of the Arts, Tokyo, Japan

- 1940** Established “Southern Asia Crafts Club”, Tainan, Taiwan
- 1941** Together with Chang Wan-Chuan, Chen Te-Wang, Hong Rui-Lin and others founded the “Zaoxing Association”, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1944** Lecturer and professor at Tainan Higher Technical Institute (now National Cheng Kung University), Tainan, Taiwan
- 1953** Worked at Provincial Industry Research Institute, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1954** Established “Nantou Crafts Learning Class”, Nantou, Taiwan
- 1957** Established “Taiwan Handicraft Promotion Center”, Taipei, Taiwan



- 1960** Taught at National Taiwan College of Arts (now National Taiwan University of Arts), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1974** Member of the “Oil Painting Society of the Republic of China”, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1976** Juror at the Department of Western Painting of the Taiwan Provincial Fine Arts Exhibition, Taipei, Taiwan
