1902-1976, born in Taichung, Taiwan

- 1918** Enrolled in Taiwan Governor-General's National Language School (now National Taipei University of Education), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1919** First time saw the oil painting by a Japanese artist in Taipei New Park (now 228 Peace Memorial Park), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1920** Self-learned oil painting at Japanese correspondence course, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1922** Graduated from Taihoku Normal School (now National Taipei University of Education), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1923** Attended drawing lessons at Masakazu Studio in Taipei as a preparation for the following studies in Japan, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1924** Enrolled in Painting Training Course at the Tokyo School of Fine Arts (now Tokyo University of the Arts), Tokyo, Japan
- 1927** Graduated from Tokyo School of Fine Arts, Tokyo, Japan
Received a teaching position in Chang Jung Senior High School, Tainan, Taiwan
Founded the "Chinyang Western Painting Society" along with Chen Cheng-po and Yen Shui-Long, Taipei, Taiwan

- 1957** Encouraged the students to set up the "Fifth Moon Group", Taipei, Taiwan
- 1962** "Liao Chi-Chun, Shiy De-Jinn Group Exhibition", United States Information Service, Taipei, Taiwan
Visited and studied in the United States with the invitation of the US Department of State, New York, USA
- 1963** Traveled and painted in Europe for several months after leaving the US
- 1964** Received the Golden Belt Award for Chinese Painting, Taiwan
- 1965** Received a teaching position at Chinese Culture University, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1970** Received the Zhongshan Literary and Art Creation Award, Taiwan
