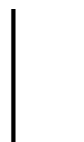


# LEE Tsai-Chien

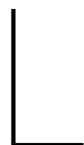
1928 born in Fujian, China

- 1948** Enrolled at the Department of Fine Arts at the Taiwan Provincial College of Education (now National Taiwan Normal University), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1950** Withdrew from college due to April 6 Incident, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1951-57** Employed as graphic artist of woven fabric patterns at printing and dyeing factory, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1957-68** Joined Taiwan Handicraft Promotion Center, specialized in design and product development, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1962-64** Founded the Six Arts Design Company, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1963** Started learning modern sculpture and creation, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1966-70** Hired by the government as Designer at International Commercial Exhibitions and Merchandise displays, Europe
- 1968-72** Taught at Chinese Culture University, Taipei, Taiwan
