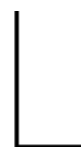


# YANG San-Lang

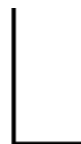
1907-1995, born in Taipei, Taiwan

## ■ CHRONOLOGY

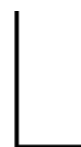
- 1920** Transferred to Suehiro High School (now Fuxing Elementary School) where only Japanese could be accepted, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1923** Left home to Japan without family's permission in March and entered Kyoto Prefectural School of Painting in April, Kyoto, Japan
- 1924** Transferred to the Western Painting Program at Kansai Art Academy, Kansai, Japan
- 1927** *Still Life* was selected for "The 1st Taiwan Fine Arts Exhibition", and was collected by Taipei's Governor Kamiyama Mitsunoshin during the Japanese colonial period, Taiwan
- 1928** Founded the "Red Island Painting Society" with other 14 artists, including Chen Cheng-po and Chen Chih-Chi, Taipei, Taiwan

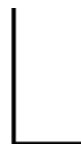

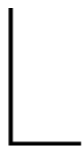
