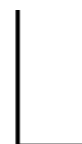


CHEN Te-Wang

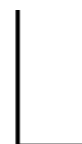
1910-1984, born in Taipei, Taiwan

■ CHRONOLOGY

- 1918** Entered Taiping Elementary School (now Taipei Municipal Taiping Elementary School), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1924** Studied art under Toho Shiozuki's supervision in Taipei State Taipei First High School (now Taipei Municipal Jianguo High School), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1927** Admitted to the Taiwanese Art Institute, founded by Ishikawa Kinichiro, where he became classmates with Hong Rui-Lin and Chang Wan-Chuan, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1928** Went to study abroad, Tokyo, Japan
- 1931** Studied painting in Hongo Painting Research Institute and Kawabata Art School, Tokyo, Japan
- 1932** Studied painting at the Research Institute for Two Disciplines, Tokyo, Japan
- 1933** Studied painting with Yasui Sotaro and Seifu Tsuda at Tsuda Private Painting School, Tokyo, Japan
- 1935** Became a member of the Taiyang Art Society, Taipei, Taiwan
