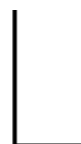


# YEN Shui-Long

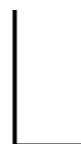
1903-1997, born in Tainan, Taiwan

- 1918** Graduated from the Tainan Government Teacher Training Department, Tainan, Taiwan
- 1922** Enrolled at the Western Painting Department of the Tokyo School of Fine Arts (now Tokyo University of the Arts), Tokyo, Japan
- 1927** Graduated from the Western Painting Department of the Tokyo School of Fine Arts, Tokyo, Japan  
Together with Chen Cheng-po, Yang San-Lang, Li Mei-Shu, Liao Chi-Chun and others formed the Red Island Painting Society, Taipei, Taiwan

- 1940** Established the Southern Asia Crafts Club, Tainan, Taiwan
- 1941** Together with Chang Wan-Chuan, Chen Te-Wang, Hong Rui-Lin and others founded the Taiwan Creative Art Forum Association, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1944** Taught architectural engineering, sketching and art history at Tainan Higher Technical Institute (now National Cheng Kung University), Tainan, Taiwan
- 1946** Review committee member for “The 1st Taiwan Provincial Fine Arts Exhibition”, Taiwan
- 1952** Published a book *Taiwan Crafts*
- 1954** Established Nantou Crafts Learning Class, Nantou, Taiwan

- 1957** Established Taiwan Handicraft Promotion Center, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1959** “The 22nd Taiyang Art Exhibition”, Taipei, Taiwan

- 1961** “The 24th Taiyang Art Exhibition”, Taipei, Taiwan

- 1974** Appointed Director of the Oil Art Society of the Republic of China, Taipei, Taiwan
