

# CHANG Wan-Chuan

1909-2003, born in Taipei, Taiwan

## ■ CHRONOLOGY

- 1920** Graduated from Shilin Public School (now Shilin Elementary School), Taipei, Taiwan
- 1929** Under the care of Ishikawa Kinichiro and with Ni Chiang-Huai's funding studied sketch drawing and watercolor painting in the Taiwanese Art Institute, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1930** Attended Kawabata Art School and Hongo Painting Research Institute with Hong Rui-Lin and Chen Te-Wang to study western painting, Tokyo, Japan  
Met Fauvist Shiotsuki Toho who had a great influence on his art, Japan  
*The Market in front of the Temple*, "The 6<sup>th</sup> Taiwan Fine Arts Exhibition", Selected, Taiwan
- 1931** Together with Hong Rui-Lin and Chen Te-Wang enrolled to Teikoku Art School (now Musashino Art University), Tokyo, Japan
- 1934** Visited Maurice de Vlaminck's exhibition for the first time and was deeply moved by his paintings, Japan
- 1936** Joined the Taiyang Art Society along with Hong Rui-Lin and Chen Te-Wang, Taipei, Taiwan
- 1937** Guided by Xu Sheng-Ji (Lu Chi-Cheng) together with Taiwanese and Japanese artists living in Xiamen organized Qingtian Painting Society, Xiamen, China
- 1938** Organized the Mouve Artist Society with Hong Rui-Lin, Chen Te-Wang, Xu Sheng-Ji, Chen Chun-Te and Huang Ching-Cheng, Taipei, Taiwan  
Taught painting in Xiamen Art Academy, Xiamen, China
